Peru was the seat of several prominent Andean civilizations, most notably that of the Incas whose empire was captured by Spanish conquistadors in 1533. Peru declared its independence in 1821, and remaining Spanish forces were defeated in 1824. After a dozen years of military rule, Peru returned to democratic leadership in 1980.

Although Peru has made great progress economically and the gospel is spreading, and the number of evangelicals has increased dramatically, many challenges remain. These include recent history of dictatorships, corruption, and violence, widespread poverty, and remaining unreached people groups among tribal peoples.
